

Standard Height of Room Electrical Distribution Box

Standard Installation Heights

- Ground-mounted boxes: Should be raised 50 to 100 mm above the floor to prevent moisture damage .
- Outdoor boxes: The bottom should be at least 1 meter above ground to avoid water exposure and climbing hazards .

Practical Considerations

- Accessibility: Mounting the box between 1.4 and 1.7 meters allows users to reach it without bending or stretching excessively, which is important for routine inspections or emergency access .
- Safety: Keep the box away from wet areas, direct water sources, or high-traffic zones to prevent accidental damage .

- Compliance: Following standards such as BS 7671 and IEC 60364-5-52 ensures the installation meets safety and operational requirements .

Installation Tips

- Ensure the box is level and perpendicular to the wall, with minimal deviation (≤ 1.5 mm for boxes under 500 mm, ≤ 3 mm for larger boxes), .
- Arrange power supply and load pipes neatly from left to right to maintain order and facilitate maintenance .
- For concealed wall installations, use a wooden box larger than the distribution box to reserve space for wiring and remove it after installation . By following these height guidelines and installation practices, the distribution box will be safe, accessible, and compliant with electrical standards, ensuring reliable operation and ease of maintenance.
