- **Circuit Overload** This occurs when too many devices or high-power appliances operate on the same circuit, exceeding its rated capacity. Examples include running a kettle, toaster, and vacuum cleaner simultaneously on one circuit. Overloads are the most frequent cause of tripping and usually resolve when some devices are turned off or redistributed across circuits .
- **Short Circuit** A short circuit happens when a live (hot) wire touches a neutral wire, causing a sudden surge of electricity. This is more serious than an overload and can pose a fire risk. It often produces a noticeable pop or bang when the breaker trips .
- **Ground Fault** A ground fault occurs when a live wire contacts a grounded surface, such as a metal outlet box or water pipe. These are particularly dangerous in wet areas like kitchens, bathrooms, or outdoor circuits .

- **Faulty Appliances or Wiring** A single defective appliance or damaged wiring can trigger the breaker. Old or improperly installed wiring, loose connections, or corroded components in the distribution box can also cause repeated trips .

Safety and Troubleshooting Steps

- Turn off the main power before inspecting any components to avoid electric shock .
- Identify the affected circuit and unplug all devices connected to it.
- Reset the breaker by switching it fully to the “off” position and then back to “on.”
- Test appliances individually to determine if one is causing the trip.
- Inspect for visible damage such as burnt marks, melted wires, or loose connections.
- Avoid repeated resets if the breaker trips immediately, as this indicates a serious fault.

If the breaker continues to trip after removing appliances or if there are signs of damaged wiring, it is essential to hire a licensed electrician. Persistent tripping may indicate a deeper electrical issue that could lead to fire or electric shock if not properly addressed .
