This warranty ensures that the equipment functions according to specifications and allows access to technical support and software updates during the coverage period.

Extended Warranty Options

For organizations requiring longer coverage, many vendors offer optional extended warranties. For example, Iron Networks provides three- and five-year extended warranties for their systems, which can include ONU modules, allowing customers to lengthen the standard warranty period beyond the basic two years. Extended warranties often include:

- Repair or replacement of defective units
- Technical support via email, phone, or online portals
- Expedited return and service for faulty equipment Components shipped separately may have shorter coverage (e.g., 30 days), but original manufacturer warranties are typically passed along to the customer .

Coverage Limitations

Warranties generally do not cover:

- Damage from unauthorized disassembly, modification, or misuse
- Natural disasters (fire, lightning, flooding)
- Improper operation or installation errors
