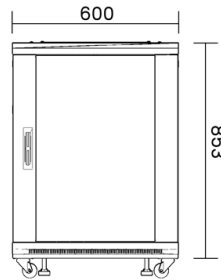

A Zero Sequence Current Transformer (ZCT), also known as a zero-phase CT, is a specialized current transformer designed to measure the vector sum of all three-phase currents passing through a cable tray ($I_a + I_b + I_c$). Under normal conditions, the sum of the three-phase currents is zero, producing no net magnetic flux in the ZCT core. When an earth fault or leakage occurs, the imbalance generates a measurable secondary current, which can trigger protective relays to trip the circuit and prevent equipment damage or hazards.

Application in Cable Trays

In cable tray installations, all three-phase conductors and the neutral (if grounded) are routed through the ZCT core. This allows the ZCT to continuously monitor for leakage currents along the tray system. Its high sensitivity enables detection of very low currents, often in the range of 4–30 mA, without being affected by external electromagnetic noise. This makes ZCTs essential for:

- Earth fault protection in industrial and commercial electrical systems
- Residual current monitoring in distribution boards and motor control centers

- Ground fault circuit interrupters for safety in cable tray networks
