A photovoltaic (PV) system control module, often called a PV controller, is a critical component in solar power systems. Its primary role is to monitor and regulate the electrical energy generated by solar panels, ensuring that batteries are charged safely and efficiently while preventing overcharging or over-discharging, which extends battery lifespan and reliability (Hilelectronic) . It also optimizes energy conversion, maximizing the usable electricity from solar panels (Hilelectronic) .

Types of Controllers

- PWM (Pulse Width Modulation) Controllers: These controllers regulate battery charging by switching the connection between panels and batteries on and off rapidly. They are simple, cost-effective, and suitable for smaller systems (Phocos) .
- MPPT (Maximum Power Point Tracking) Controllers: MPPT controllers adjust the electrical operating point of the panels to extract maximum power, improving efficiency, especially in larger or variable-light systems (Phocos) .
