

What is the fixing spacing of cable tray cover plates



Overview

On vertical cable trays and on edgewise - horizontal cable trays, each cable shall be fixed with 20mm wide stainless steel strips (two per meter). Not all cable trays are equivalent. The mechanical and electrical characteristics, tests, certifications, overall quality management, recommendations mentioned in this technical guide only apply to our own cable management ranges and cannot under any circumstances be transpos the enclosure. This guide covers cable ladder systems, cable tray systems, channel support systems and associated supports intended for the support and accommodation of cables and possibly other electrical equipment in electrical and/or communication systems installations. This guide does not apply to conduit. Correct tray sizing and loading are essential to avoid overloading and to maintain good cable management. Determine the total cable weight per unit length and verify that the selected tray type and width can support that load at the chosen support span.
