- **Polish Types:** SC interfaces can accept UPC (Ultra Physical Contact) or APC (Angled Physical Contact) connectors, with APC typically used in PON networks to reduce back-reflection.

- Standards: The SC interface conforms to IEC 61754-4 and TIA-604-3, with end-face geometry defined in IEC 61755-3-1 .

Practical Considerations

- Ensure the SC connector is fully inserted until the snap-in latch clicks, confirming proper engagement.
- Avoid mixing SC/UPC and SC/APC connectors on the same coupler, as this can cause high insertion loss and potential damage to the ferrule end-face .
- SC interfaces are commonly used in FTTH, CATV, PON, and enterprise networks, and remain standard for outdoor and legacy installations due to their robustness .
