- Enclosure: Use a NEMA-rated box suitable for the environment, such as NEMA 3R for outdoor use, to protect against weather and dust .

Wiring Guidelines

- Wire Sizing: Determine the maximum amperage the box will handle. For example, a 50A inlet requires at least 6 AWG copper conductors for hot, neutral, and ground wires .
- Branch Circuits: Each outlet or group of outlets should have its own circuit breaker and appropriately sized wire to prevent overload .
- Grounding: Ensure all metal parts and receptacles are properly grounded to reduce shock hazards .
- Strain Relief: Use bushings or clamps where cables enter or exit the enclosure to prevent wear and accidental contact with energized parts .

Safety and Compliance

- Follow NEC (National Electrical Code) and OSHA requirements for temporary wiring .
- Only authorized personnel should install or modify the box .
- Use GFCI-protected outlets for 120V circuits to prevent electrocution .
- Inspect the box regularly for damage, loose connections, or wear, especially in high-traffic or outdoor areas .
